**PREOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS:** Entropion      Right / Left

**POSTOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS:** Same

**OPERATION:** Repair of Entropion using Quickert Sutures.

**PROCEDURE:** The patient was prepped and draped in the usual manner. Injection of Xylocaine 2% with Epinephrine was given in the infraorbital and lacrimal nerve area so that anesthesia was obtained in the lower lid. Tetracaine was placed in the operated eye. Next, using forceps and 5-0 chromic double-arm suture, one suture starting from the deep inferior fornix all the way up to the exiting out 2 mm below the lid margin on the lower lid. This was placed in approximately the center of the lower lid. A drop of antibiotic was placed in the eye. Patient tolerated the procedure well and left the operating room in good condition.
