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Pre Operative Diagnosis: Dermatochalasis Right / Left / Both

Post Operative Diagnosis: Same

Name Of Operation: Repair of Dermatochalsis Right / Left / Both

Anesthesia: Local Lidocaine 1% with epinephrine

Procedure: The patient was prepped and draped in the usual manner. Redundant Upper lid skin was identified and marked accordingly. A lid block in the upper lid was given. Using a 15 blade and sharp wescott scissors the marked oval area of skin was removed from the upper lid. Hemostasis was achieved using manual pressure. The remaining skin edges was approximated using a running suture with 5-0 nylon. Erythromycin ointment was placed over the eye. Patient tolerated the procedure well and was discharged in stable condition.
