POSTOPERATIVE DIAGNOSIS: Same

OPERATION: YAG Anterior Vitreolysis

ANESTHESIA: Topical – Proparacaine 1/2%

PROCEDURE: Topical Proparacaine 1/2% was placed in the patient's eye. The patient was positioned at the YAG laser. An Abraham capsulotomy lens was placed in the eye using Goniosol. The Vitreous was isolated near the pupil margin. In the area, a series of _____ laser pulses, each approximately _____ millijoules in power, was used to create an separation in the Vitreous . At the conclusion of the procedure, the Vitreous strand was separated completely, and the lens was removed from the eye. The patient tolerated the procedure and left in good condition.
